The Australian Day Council of New South Wales invites you to take part in CARnivale to be held on **Australia Day, Monday 26 January 2015**.

CARnivale continues the tradition from 1986 when the first Australia Day motoring event was held in The Rocks. Today CARnivale is one of the largest displays of vehicles in the southern hemisphere and a major part of Sydney's Australia Day festivities.

To display your veteran, vintage or classic vehicle, it must be over 30 years old and built *before* 31st *December* 1984 or be an identical model run-on.

The closing date for all entries is **Friday 14 November 2014** or earlier if the total allocation of space has been filled. Entries are accepted on a first-in basis, depending on the number and variety of vehicles

If your registration is accepted you will receive a letter confirming arrival times and further details on the event in mid-December

WHAT HAPPENS ON THE DAY

- Assembly of vehicles will commence at the Domain Car Park from 6.00 am.
- Free breakfast will be provided in the car park forecourt by the Rotary Club of Granville.
- Vehicles will travel in convoys from 7.00 am to their designated display positions.
- For crowd safety reasons vehicles must stay in their allocated position until 5:00 pm when they may leave under the direction of police and marshals.
- Marshals will assist drivers to position vehicles according to the space available.
- Entrants displaying flags or banners must affix them to their vehicles only and not to fences or buildings.
- No portable cooking facilities may be used in or around vehicles on display.
- No temporary structures, gazebos, tents or sunshades are to be erected in the precinct.
